Action Request Summary

On June 14, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing to take testimony about the local impacts of cryptocurrency mining operations and to consider the possibility of interim zoning to temporarily restrict new and expanded cryptocurrency mining operations in the unincorporated portions of the county.
